- 1. All presenters must adhere to the time given for the presentation (7 min for the presentation and 2 min for Q & A)
- 2. Slides should be clear and visible
- 3. The evaluation will be based on the following aspects of your presentation
  - Organization of the talk
    Introduction, Body, Summary, Reference to Other Work, Other Aspects
  - Clarity in the talk

Layout and organization, Density of Information, Illustration of critical points
